Boca West Children's Foundation Announces World Soccer Championship Ticket Raffle

BOCA RATON, Fla., Jan. 16, 2026- Friday morning, [Boca West Children's Foundation](#) announced a [ticket raffle](#) to the World Soccer Championship. The first-place winner's prize includes tickets to the tournament final on July 19 at 3 p.m. at MetLife Stadium in New Jersey. The winner also will receive \$1,500 in spending money.

Second-place winners get a two-night stay at the Wyndham Boca Raton Hotel along with \$250 in cash. Third-place winners receive a \$500 gift card to NYE Steak Restaurant at Seminole Casino in Coconut Creek.

As of Jan. 15, tickets for the game were priced at \$10,000 and up. Raffle tickets cost \$100 each. The event, which marks the first tournament final held in North America in three decades, with proceeds from raffle tickets benefiting the foundation and its charity partners.

The raffle follows a recent Boca West Children's Foundation drawing for tickets to football's biggest night, which included a \$1,500 cash prize. A second-place winner received a stay at Eau Palm Beach Resort & Spa along with \$250 spending money. A third-place winner received \$500 in gift certificates to restaurants throughout Boca Raton.

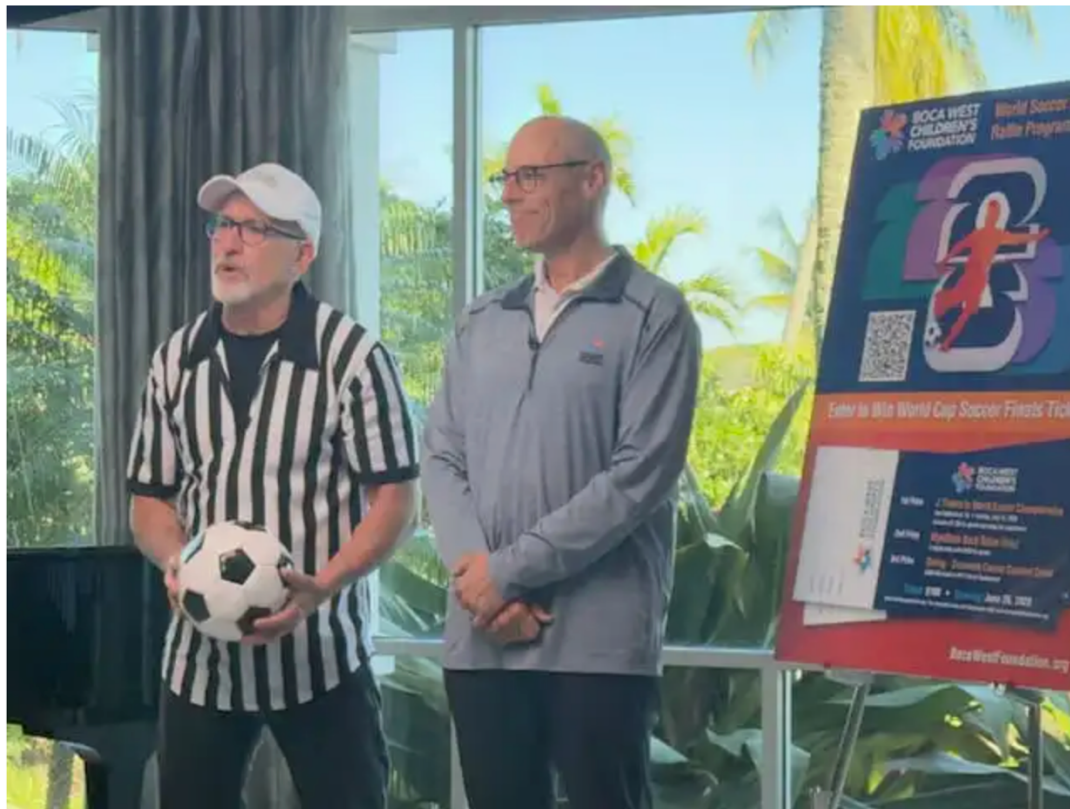
Boca West Children's Foundation regularly hosts ticket raffles and special events, including golf outings, galas, the annual Old Navy Boys & Girls Club Holiday event, a CEO Breakfast, semiannual meetings, and the Duck Drop.

Raffle tickets are sold by the foundation's charity partners, allowing those organizations to raise funds for projects that serve underserved kids and families in Palm Beach County. Event proceeds benefit the foundation, which covers the operational costs, and its charity partners, which fund specific projects serving underserved children and families in Palm Beach County. Areas of support include basic needs such as diapers, shelter, and beds. The foundation also supports foster care, food security and holiday meals, literacy programs, after-school programs, tutoring, scholarships, and summer programs. Boca West Children's Foundation also supports special-needs programs throughout the community.

In addition to event and raffle proceeds, Boca West Children's Foundation accepts online donations. The foundation also offers grant and project funding opportunities, through which charities may submit detailed project proposals and financial information. Through this process, the foundation provides grants for clearly defined projects that align with its mission. Beyond financial support, the foundation mentors partner charities to help ensure that their goals are met.

Founded 16 years ago, Boca West Children's Foundation has grown from fewer than five charities to 30 charity partners. Its mission is "to invest in the future of Palm Beach County's most vulnerable children and families by identifying critical needs, funding effective solutions, and building on our proven track record of measurable impact."
